

AP Major Works Data Sheet Instructions

You will read a handful of full length texts in preparation for the AP English Literature exam in May 2027.

In order to receive full credit for reading each book, you will fill out this document, and you must adhere to the following guidelines.

1. FULL MLA HEADING EACH TIME YOU SUBMIT - no heading = no credit.
2. Describe the author's style - 3 sentences minimum.
3. An example of their style - 3 quotes minimum.
4. Memorable Quotes - 10 quotes minimum - roughly 3 from beginning, middle and end of the work. You must number your quotes as well.
5. Characters - minimum of 8-10. You must number your characters as well.
6. Setting - 3 sentences minimum, especially as chapter to chapter settings can change.
7. Symbols - 5 minimum - remember, symbols are often objects which represent something else in order to enhance meaning and significance.
8. Themes - 5 minimum.
