Over the summer, complete the following:

Handwritten Notes (2 Pages Minimum):

Focus on **one** of the following literary elements:

- Theme What ideas or messages are developed in the story?
- Character Development How does a main character change over the course of the novel?
- **Plot Structure** How is the story organized? What are the major plot points?
- Literary Devices How does the author use symbolism, foreshadowing, irony, or imagery?

Guidelines:

- Use bullet points or full sentences.
- Include **specific references to the text** (include page numbers for your writing assignment in August).
- Show your thinking—not just what happened, but what it means or why it matters.

When You Return to School:

- 3. Write a short in-class response on your chosen literary focus, using your notes to support your ideas.
